Shepherd News

Welcome to fall programming. Well, not that all programming ceased over the summer, but a significant portion will be gearing back up shortly. We (staff) are excited as we anticipate getting back into the steady routine of Bible study, worship, fellowship, and service for Jesus—otherwise known as **“Worship” “Serve” “Grow” and “Connect”**.

We have had those banners hanging from our ceilings for almost 10 years, although recently not much attention was given to them. This fall, we will be reemphasizing our goal as **“fully devoted followers of Christ”** (from our mission statement), by emphasizing these four key areas that we should all be involved in as fully devoted followers of Christ.

To make the point, we will be replacing the banners we have with new ones, which will also be coordinated with other efforts to put focus in these areas. When we promote a ministry or event, we will have signups on tables with tablecloths promoting the type of event (connect, grow, or serve). Our announcements in the bulletin are also designed to identify the nature of an event (connect, growth, or servanthood).

We will also see (or you may have already seen) other changes throughout the church. A new screen (both front and back) necessitated by new video equipment in the media room. The old equipment was outdated and, in some cases, failing or soon to lose technical support. Curtains have been removed from the nursery to provide better transparency and safety (a smaller curtain is being installed in an area of the room to provide nursing moms with privacy). The Lifetree Café area has recently been simplified in its decorating to ease transitions when used for other purposes. We also have a new TV in that area. We will have a new, beefed up public Wifi that will work in the basement. Most of these changes were funded by a generous donation from Nancy Gilpin who went to be with the Lord last year.

Not only is our facility ready to go, so are our teachers and bible study leaders, and they eager to share the good news of Jesus Christ as told through the Scriptures. We will continue the creation theme (introduced by Dr. Rob Carter's visit in August), with a creation Bible study on Wednesday evenings. “Each Day Club” has had a makeover, and is now called **“Kids for Christ”**. Changes have been made in the Sunday school area to create a more favorable environment to grow. We will continue to offer Pastor-led Bible studies on Sunday morning and men's and women's Bible studies on Monday evenings and Tuesday & Wednesday mornings.

We have also been making a bigger mark in the world. Our support for mission work in Chile continued with a donation and trip in July. St. Andrews Family Shelter ministry is thriving and active as we serve people there. And we are beginning our Safe Family initiative to help provide temporary living arrangements for children in need. We will continue to have outreach programs like the amazing Jeffo (blind Christian magician). Details forthcoming. There is much more I could share if I had the space.

I would like to thank all who have walked through these changes with us. Change can be very difficult. But through it all, our goal is to make this a wonderful place for people to come, worship and grow in their connection (to God and to each other), serve, and learn. Thank you to all who served and will continue to serve their Lord in this church community. **We are making a difference.**

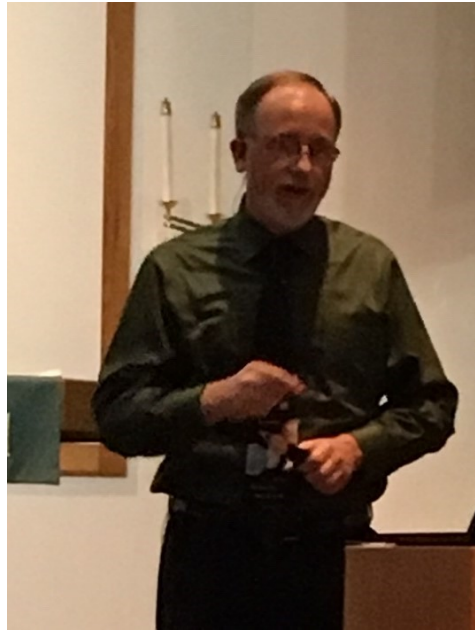

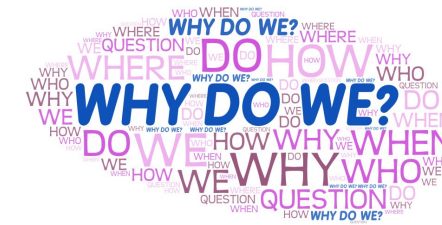

Welcome to a new feature called "**Why Do We?**" Each month we will highlight different objects or traditions that are a part of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church and explain more about them.

The dark red light near the altar is called the **Eternity Candle**. It has a candle that burns continuously as a reminder that God is always present. It also indicates the presence of Christ in the sanctuary, as well as a belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the bread and wine. Another reason to burn the lamp is to show that the light of Christ always burns in a sin-darkened world.

In July, the shelter celebrated its first anniversary of service to the community. Congratulations and many thanks to all the people that have donated time or other contributions to help get and keep the doors open!

Here are some facts from the past year:

- Housed 17 families
- Provided 730 meals
- Involved with 2 Eagle Scout Projects and One Gold Scout Project
- Over 1200 volunteers
- 1,248 volunteer hours for dinner shifts
- 4,745 volunteer hours for overnight shifts
- Poured 400 gallons of milk
- Fried 647 pounds of hamburger
- Gave 55 people warm beds to sleep in
- Provided 15 gallons of shampoo

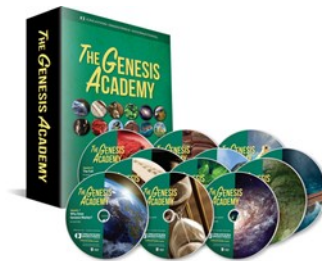

Don't throw Away Youth Ink Cartridges!

Our Youth has launched a fundraising project with the help of an inkjet recycling company **Empties4Cash**. Empty inkjet cartridges can be recycled and remanufactured. Our group will receive up to \$4.00 for each cartridge turned in.

You can help! Any inkjet cartridge with a print head can be recycled, regardless of brand or type. Do you have an HP, Lexmark, Xerox, Compaq, Brother, Dell, Canon, or Apple printer?

Bring in your empty OEM inkjet cartridges (placed in the original box that you would have thrown away to keep it safe from spills and damages, or a Ziploc bag) to the school..

(Note: Epson cartridges cannot be recycled – they don't have a print head.)

Deposit them in the basket on top of the coatrack in the Lobby.
