




Solar Eclipse

There will be a partial solar eclipse on October 14, 2023 between 10:29AM. and 1:11PM. Even though it's only a partial eclipse, solar eclipses are fairly rare, and it's still pretty cool to watch the moon cover up the sun! Come to the solar eclipse viewing event at Bethel University to safely observe the eclipse using one of Bethel's telescopes with a solar filter or a pair of eclipse glasses.

Important Safety: Do not look directly at the Sun unless you are looking through either a solar filter or eclipse glasses. Sunglasses are not sufficient protection.

This event is weather-permitting. Check the website <u>HERE</u> on the day of the event in case of cancellation due to poor observing conditions.

up in the lobby to do a trunk, donate candy, or other jobs.








The activation of the church's new security system is coming soon. We've had a couple of delays and are working on training materials. We thank you for your willingness to help us make our church as secure as possible.








The goal is to implement this security system as soon as possible with documentation and training being made available before implementation.
