

Have you heard that humans and chimps


have 98% of their DNA in common, proof that we evolved from them? Have you heard about the millions and billions of years needed to form our landscape?

March 23rd from 10:00AM to Noon Walk through various stations and learn about the Easter Story as told through the Resurrection Eggs.


Easter Resurrection Egg Walk
